



Hillside Outside 2020 Camping Terms & Conditions

Please retain these terms and conditions for future reference:

We ask all of our campers to comply with our policies otherwise we may have to ask you to leave the site.

- * The onsite campsite must be booked in advance. Camping is available from 1900 on Friday 22 May 2020 and you can stay until the morning of Sunday 24 May 2020 for a fee of £15 per pitch per night. All you need to do is show your booking confirmation on arrival to the parking attendant.
- * Camping pitches are allocated on a first come, first served basis.
- * One pitch is approximately 8x4m for a tent or campervan
- * You can park up to one vehicle in one pitch next to your camping pitch
- * Please note no gazebos/ezups due to wind/safety considerations
- * No electric hook up or drinking water available
- * Showers and toilet facilities are available at the Forest Enterprise Scotland's visitor centre
- * Under 16s must be supervised
- * Campsite must be vacated on Sunday 24 May by 12:00 noon latest.
- * Speed limit is 5mph in the camping field
- * Vehicle movement on the site is prohibited between 23:00 and 07:00.
- * Strictly no open fires, no BBQ's and no naked flames
- * The organisers are not responsible for any misplaced, lost or stolen items
- * All camping attendees are subject to search upon entry
- * No spirits allowed on site
- * Dogs are allowed but must be on a lead at all times. You are responsible for cleaning up after them.
- * Fire extinguishers are located at the gate of the camping field
- * No noise in the camping fields after 11pm
- * Campers are expected to behave in a manner that is courteous to other campers at all times
- * Please consider other users of the site and we ask that all users conduct themselves at all times with due regard to the health and safety of themselves and others.
- * Please leave your camping pitch free of any litter
- * In the event of poor ground conditions, a pitch may not be available. The Event Organisers will endeavour to advise you in advance should this occur but no responsibility can be accepted if this is not possible.
- * The Event Organisers will not accept responsibility for any loss or damage to the property of the visitor, including personal belongings, cash, jewellery, bicycles and motor vehicles, however, caused during their camping stay.
