Registration

Opens at 10.00am.

Compulsory Bike Check

Compulsory Bike Check for all riders (please ensure you have registered prior to the Bike Check).

Mini Mash Up: Solo riders.

- Mini Mash Up 1 | Any bike | 11.00am – 11.20am | up to 6 years
- Mini Mash Up 2 | Any bike | 11.25am – 11.45am | up to 6 years
- Mini Mash Up 2 | Any bike | 11.50am – 12.10am | up to 6 years

Mega Mash Up: Teams of 2 riders.

- Mega Mash Up 1 | Pedal bikes | 1.00pm – 1.30pm | 6 - 7 years
- Mega Mash Up 2 | Pedal bikes | 1.40pm – 2.10pm | 6 - 7 years

Mighty Mash Up: Teams of 2 riders.

- Mighty Mash up 1 | Team of 2 riders* | 2.30pm - 3.20pm | 8 - 9 years
- Mighty Mash up 2 | Teams of 2 riders* | 3.30pm - 4.20pm | 10 - 11 years



Registration

Registration will be at the Ridelines and Frog Bikes stand in the festival village (number 1 and 2). Please see the site map [here](#). We'll have lots of children registering and we will process riders as quickly as we can.

Please ensure you get to registration at least 30 mins before your session starts.

One parent/guardian can register for both children in the pair and collect their number board and cables ties.

Bike Check

Once you have registered please make your way to the bike check. All equipment used at an event must be fit for purpose and ridden / used at riders own risk.

Bar end plugs must be fitted.

Children must have their bikes checked before they will be allowed to ride the course.

Safety

Children must ride safely, in control and within the limits of their ability at all times – this includes when overtaking.

The following must be adhered to at all times:

- Cycling helmets MUST be worn and fastened at all times during the event.
- Any participants who persistently misbehave or put others in danger will be asked to leave the activity and will not be allowed to continue.
- A parent or responsible adult MUST remain on site for the duration of event. Adult name and contact for this person can be confirmed/recorded at registration on the day.
- All equipment used at the event must be fit for purpose and ridden / used at riders own risk.
- Bikes must be checked before the event.

Compulsory

- Cycling helmets MUST be worn at all times during the event.
- Gloves are recommended
- Bike in full working order, including bar end plugs
- No stabilisers or three wheelers allowed.
- Appropriate clothing for the weather (rain jacket and sun cream etc)
