

Times & checking in	 <u>Check in time</u> Friday 28th - check in open between 16:00 – 20:00 Saturday 29th - check in open between 08:00 – 12:00 Saturday 29th - check in open between 17:00 – 20:00 Sunday 30th - check in open between 07:30 – 09:00 <u>Check out time</u> Monday 1st May – check out by 10:00 If you arrive after 10pm, you will not be able to enter the campsite unless you have contacted us in advance – info@tweedlove.com In an effort to save paper, you will not be required to print off a camping pass. Just ensure you have your email confirmation ready and show that to the camp manager.
Accessibility – Important (see last page)	There will be an entrance/exit for vehicles at the top of the field only. At the bottom of the field is a separate entrance/exit for bikes/pedestrians only. This will be sign posted and the Campsite Manager will direct people and the traffic flow.

Facilities	Portable toilets will be available at the campsite (bring your own toilet toll, we
	don't have staff on site over night to refill, this goes for water too)
	Water is available, but please note it is not officially drinking water.
	Showers are available at the Gytes Leisure Centre, EH45 8GL, a very short walk from the festival village on Tweed Green.
	They will be open to campers at the below times. They will be free of charge. Saturday 29 th – 9am – 11am Sunday 30 th – 5pm – 8pm
	There is no electric hook up available and there is no lighting on the field. Bring a torch for walking to your pitch in the evening.
	We take recycling home.
Conduct	The campsite is located in a residential area; it is vital that you respect the neighbours and the land. You must leave the pitch as you found it and put all rubbish/recycling in the bins provided.
	Noise must stop at 22:00 and vehicle movement is prohibited between 22:00 and 07:00.
	Gazebos/ezups are not allowed due to wind/safety considerations and there is a policy of strictly no open fires, no BBQ's and no naked flames. Under 16s must be supervised by a responsible adult and dogs are allowed, but they must be on a lead at all times. You are responsible for cleaning up after them.
	Speed limit is 5mph in the camping field.
Security	We take no responsibility for loss or damage to items left at the campsite. Please note that there will be no overnight security provided.
Local Amenities	<u>Hospital</u> – there is a small injuries unit at HayLodge Medical Centre in Peebles EH45 8JG. The nearest A&E is at Borders General Hospital in Melrose.
	<u>Fire Station</u> – Caledonian Road, Peebles, EH45 9DL.
	Public Transport – nearest train station Galashiels Station. Bus service x62.
	<u>Major Roads</u> – the site is just off the A72, about 28 miles south of Edinburgh. Directions to the campsite ans festival will be well signposted in Peebles.
	<u>Local Services</u> – festival site is next to Peebles town with local supermarkets, pubs, chemist, public toilets, cafes.

Campsite terms and conditions

We ask all of our campers to comply with our policies otherwise we may have to ask you to leave the site.

- * Camping pitches are allocated on a first come, first served basis.
- * One pitch per tent or vehicle.
- * You can park one vehicle per pitch.
- * Max 2 people per pitch, under 16s can stay with family
- * Toilet facilities are available.
- * No electric hook up available.
- * Please note there's no gazebos/ezups allowed due to wind/safety considerations.
- * Strictly no open fires, no BBQ's and no naked flames.
- * No noise in the camping fields after 22:00.
- * Vehicle movement on the site is prohibited between 22:00 and 07:00.
- * Speed limit is 5mph in the camping field.
- * Under 16s must be supervised by a responsible adult
- * Dogs are allowed but must be on a lead at all times. You are responsible for cleaning up after them.
- * The organisers are not responsible for any misplaced, lost or stolen items.
- * Fire extinguishers are located at the gate of the camping field.
- * Campers are expected to behave in a manner that is courteous to other campers at all times.
- * Please consider other users of the site and we ask that all users always conduct themselves with due regard to the health and safety of themselves and others.
- * Please leave your camping pitch free of any litter.
- * In the event of poor ground conditions, a pitch may not be available. The Event Organisers will endeavour to advise you in advance should this occur but no responsibility can be accepted if this is not possible.
- * The Event Organisers will not accept responsibility for any loss or damage to the property of the visitor, including personal belongings, cash, jewellery, bicycles, and motor vehicles, however, caused during their camping stay.
- * Leave your pitch as you find it, respect the environment, littering is frowned upon
- * You can bring alcohol, but please be responsible and respect others.
