

TWEEDLOVE BIKE DEMO TERMS & CONDITIONS

Please note that by taking part in the TweedLove Bike Demo you have agreed to the below Terms & Conditions.

Riders must be over 16 to use the demo website and make bookings. Riders must be competent enough to control all demo bikes and e-bikes.

Damage and/or loss

Demonstration bicycles are the responsibility of the participant who is demo-ing/riding the bike, and loss, damage or misuse must be paid in full.

In the case of any damage/loss, the brand will be responsible for acquiring payment from the participant – TweedLove will pass all the participants' information on to the brand.

Protection

Mobile phones and helmets are compulsory, the latter must be done up properly at all times. Either open or full-face helmets are permitted.

Gloves, knee pads and elbow pads are strongly advised.

Safety

Signage will be in place warning traffic of the event, but riders are always responsible for their own safety.

The transition/linking sections may include public roads with traffic present, where you must ride responsibly and considerately, and follow the Highway Code at all times. For riders from abroad, please remember to ride on the left.

Waver of Liability

Every rider understands and admits that their participation is voluntary. They assume full responsibility for any injuries or damages from their participation. They recognise and understand that the activities may be hazardous and that their participation is solely at their own risk.

Every rider affirms, that they are in good health. They declare that they are physically fit and capable to participate.

Every rider has to acknowledge that they have read and understand this entire waiver of liability and agrees to be legally bound by it.
