

Enjoyro EVO FAQs 2024

HOW AND WHEN DO I GET FURTHER INFORMATION ABOUT THE EVENT?

Make sure you are following us on [Instagram](#) and [Facebook](#) for all the latest news. We will send you all the specific event details in the form of Riders' Notes approximately one week before the event. This will include info on the final event schedule, registration, the course, facilities and much more.

CAN I RIDE WITH MY MATES?

Yes! Just tell us at event registration and we'll give you the same start time.

WHAT IS THE ELEVATION AND HOW MANY STAGES ARE THERE?

Course info will be released ahead of time and send out to you.

DO I HAVE TO BRING MY PRINTED TICKET TO THE EVENT?

Nope! All you need to do is show us your email confirmation. We'd prefer if you didn't print it, every little counts.

CAN YOU RECOMMEND ANY ACCOMODATION?

WHAT ARE MY TRANSPORT/PARKING OPTIONS FOR GETTING TO AND FROM THE EVENT?

Parking and camping details will follow in the Riders' Notes that will be issued approximately one week prior to the event.

CAN I TRANSFER MY ENTRY TO ANOTHER PERSON?

Yes, you can swap your entry to a different rider through SiEntries; follow these instructions and you can do so up to one month prior to the event. After this, no transfers are available.

- Go to the **My Entries/Memberships** tab,
- Click **Edit** on the entry,
- Then **Edit/Substitute** on the entry you want to change,
- Then **Substitute**,
- You will need to click **Next**, tick the disclaimers again and **Save Entry** to confirm.

For safety reasons, NO rider may use another's rider's event number without the permission of the event organiser.

CAN I DEFER MY ENTRY TO 2025?

Yes, you can defer your entry to 2025's event up to one month prior to this year's event.

TICKETS ARE SOLD OUT, IS THERE A WAITING LIST?

Yes, we operate a waiting list which you can access through SiEntries. We normally post on our socials when a waiting list is opened.

WHAT'S THE REFUND POLICY?

SiEntries are working with XCover and all refund requests **must** go through them. XCover is available at the time of ticket purchase; we highly recommend you add this option. Purchasing XCover allows you to apply for a refund in case you are unable to attend due to unforeseen circumstances outside of your control. Please see the XCover [terms and conditions](#) to find out if you are eligible for a refund.

If you are unable to attend the event and did not purchase XCover, no refund will be issued. You can transfer to the same event the following year up until 28 days before the event date and can do so by emailing info@tweedlove.com.

ARE THERE MINIMUM AGE REQUIREMENTS TO ENTER THE EVENT?

Yes – you must be 12 years old by 25th August 2024 to enter the TweedLove Enduro Series. Racers under the age of 16 must be signed on by their parent, or other legal guardian.

If you are entering a rider under 16 years, you confirm that you have seen and agreed to the [Parental Consent Terms here](#).

WHAT IS A FEED STATION?
